

A macro-perspective for the future



Abhinav Ram Reddy, Executive Director, GAR Corporation, participated in a recent episode of a conference call series to discuss risks and strategies for the post-Covid world organized by the Milken Institute.

"The impact of Covid-19 on Real Estate Investment" was the topic of discussion and the below is an excerpt from Abhinav's view of what the future holds:

"Overall, the negative sentiment is outweighing positive sentiment in the short-term. In the medium to long-term, I believe the story is fairly solid. Given India's young population, our recovery is likely to be much faster. In general what we've seen in the last two down cycles, which was 2001 and 2008-2009, is that whenever there is a lot of cost pressure on corporates in the European Union region and the USA, they tend to cut costs by off shoring more jobs.

So, within a year or so, I think we should see more demand coming in for long-term office space in the Asia-Pacific region, both in India and places like Vietnam and Philippines. So, that's a good sign. We just have to wait it out."

The 5S approach: A mission-critical battle-plan

In helping the Laxmi Infobahn community combat Covid-19 and deal with the fall-out of this global onslaught, GAR Corp marshalled scientific expertise, resources and a Pandemic Response Team (PRT) led by Lt. Col. Ramesh Menon, Director - Facilities & Amenities.

Having been on the frontlines of conventional wars, he leads the charge against Covid-19 with a strong sense of responsibility to protect the community leveraging clear strategies and effective deployment of resources. The objectives of the PRT is to ensure the seamless, uninterrupted operation of all mission-critical infrastructure and to maintain a safe COVID free workplace.

GAR's pandemic preparedness plan defined by Lt. Col. Ramesh is encapsulated in the 5S approach comprising: Screening, Segregating, Social distancing, Sanitizing and Sensitizing.

The 5S approach is foundational to the SOP and defines the framework for GAR's pandemic response. In order to define clear guidance for all stakeholders, a comprehensive SOP manual was formulated. The SOP document details guidelines and protocols across the spectrum of GAR's Covid response.

Implemented by the Pandemic Response Team (PRT), the mandate is to ensure adherence to the outlined measures across all GAR Buildings/Offices. Our objective is to provide a safe and secure workplace for employees and contract workers of GAR Laxmi Infobahn and its clients.



The SOP framework

The 5S approach

Screening: Screening: Screening is carried out at campus entry points using thermal cameras and digital Infrared Thermometers to identify potential infection threats.

Segregating: People who display symptoms of illness are segregated from others and notified to respective HR / FM Authorities.

Social distancing: Measures like Queue Masters at entry points, Floor Markings at lobbies, Elevators, Food Courts are in place to help employees keep safe distance.

Sanitizing: The key to minimizing the pandemic's impact is to create awareness. Well-planned awareness campaigns enlist digital and print media to sensitize all stakeholders. The GAR Centre of Excellence drives the sensitization and communication of this SOP to all the stakeholders. Clients are advised to take similar measures for awareness amongst their associates.

Sensitizing: The key to minimizing the pandemic's impact is to create awareness. Well planned awareness campaigns enlist digital and print media to sensitize all stakeholders. SOP in action

While we adhere to stringent SOPs to stop the spread of the pandemic, we ensure these measures are implemented sensitively and with care.

Here we spotlight a few key macro and micro aspects of our pandemic response.

Screening

- ▶ Temperature check for all visitors
- ▶ Pedestrian screening at the gate
- ▶ Screening of vehicles at the entry point

Sanitization

Frequent sanitization of:

- ▶ Open spaces and common areas
- ▶ All common touchpoints
- ▶ Workstations
- ▶ Food court & cafeteria
- ▶ Cooling tower
- ▶ Touch-free soap dispenser

Social distancing and contactless access

- ▶ Limited occupancy in elevators
- ▶ Use of stairs encouraged
- ▶ Floor markers to promote social distancing
- ▶ Open doors
- ▶ Automated, hands-free and foot-operated doors

Business Continuity Management

- ► Monitoring through Building Management System (BMS)
- ▶ Optimally maintained equipment to support business continuity
- ▶ Improved indoor air quality in compliance with ISHRAE COVID 19 Guidelines
